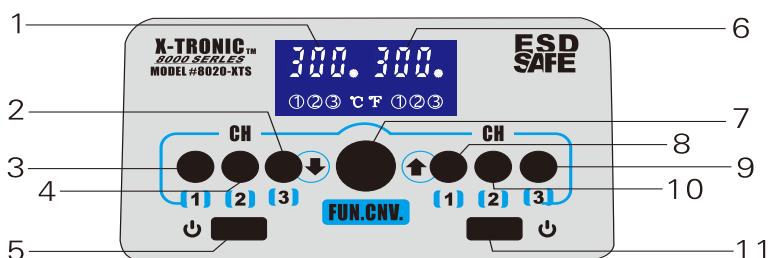
## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

1. When not in use always turn the power off and unplug the unit from the electrical outlet.
2. Never use the soldering iron near any flammable substance, material, or gas.
3. Never touch the metallic components of the soldering iron while they are in use. The items are extremely hot and will cause serious burns instantly. Allow the unit to properly cool to room temperature before attempting to touch them.
4. Do not use the unit for any application other than soldering.
5. Do not tap the soldering tip against the work surface to remove residual solder - this can damage the soldering tip and/or heating element.
6. Do NOT modify the unit in any way.
7. When replacing consumable parts, only use approved manufacturer parts.
8. Do not get the unit wet or use when your hands are wet.
9. The soldering process can produce smoke - ensure the area is well ventilated.

# PRODUCT SET-UP









1. Unpack all of the contents of the X-Tronic #8020-XTS unit and Inspect the unit and accessories for any damage. If damage is detected, please contact X-Tronic immediately (see back of manual for contact information)..
2. Attach the soldering iron to the unit using the soldering iron connection and place the soldering iron into the holder.
3. Attach the hot tweezers to the unit using the hot tweezer connection and place the tweezers into the holder.
4. Ensure all of the connections are secure and correct before applying power to the unit.
5. Plug the power cord into a GROUNDED AC wall outlet.
6. Turn on the main power switch located on the back of the unit.
7. Power on the unit.
  - a. Soldering Iron
    - i. Power on the soldering iron with the Iron power switch.
    - ii. Adjust the soldering iron temperature by pressing the soldering iron ↑ and ↓ buttons.
  - b. Hot Tweezers
    - i. Turn on the hot tweezers by means of the Hot Tweezers power switch.
    - ii. Adjust the hot air temperature by using the hot air gun ↑ and ↓ buttons.

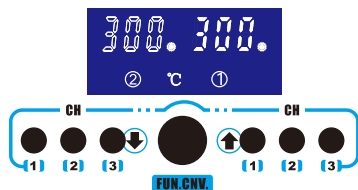
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Connect the soldering iron and the machine.</li> <li>2. Plug on the power cord.</li> <li>3. Switch on main power switch, display <b>--- ---</b> means enter into standby state.</li> </ol>	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>4. Switch on Tweezers/ soldering station 1 or soldering station 2, display relatively temperature (original display CH1 memory temperature), 3 seconds, begin to heating up quickly. You can normally work when temperature stable.</li> </ol>

Adjust tweezers/ soldering station 1 current temperature: Press <b>FUN.CNV.</b> key, the current temperature flashing.</li> </ol> <p>Press  key (heating up) or  key (cooling down) adjust soldering iron temperature. 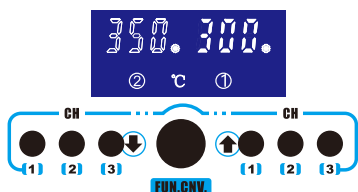

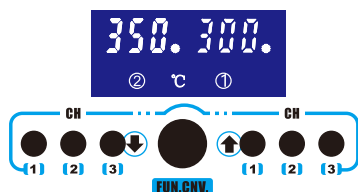
1-1. Open the main power switch, tweezers/ soldering station 1 power switch, the screen display CH1 memory temperature, press left panel **(2)** key, converse to CH2 memory temperature.  
 1-2. You can open soldering station 2 power switch at the same time.



2-1. Press **FUN.CNV.** key ,temperature flashing.  
 2-2. When soldering station 2 power on at the same time, if press **FUN.CNV.** one more time, it will change to soldering station 2 CH1 temperature memory adjust.



3. Press **↓** key(cooling down) or **↑** (heating up) adjust to desired temperature. For example:350°C (long press the key -heating up or cooling down quickly, short press the key-heating up or cooling down step-by-step)



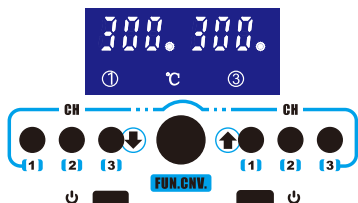
4. Adjust the temperature, stop operation. Tweezers/ soldering station 1 CH2 temperature flashing 6 times, system will auto memory data. The screen display tweezers/ soldering station 1 CH2 set temperature 3 seconds, soldering station 1 CH2 setting completed.

Tweezers/ soldering station 1 CH1/CH3 memory temperature setting is the same with Ch2. After setting, can select tweezers/ soldering station 1 CH1/CH2/ CH3 enter into relevant temperature to solder.

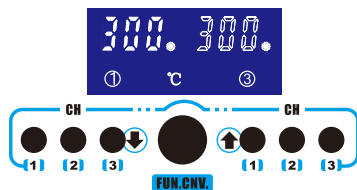

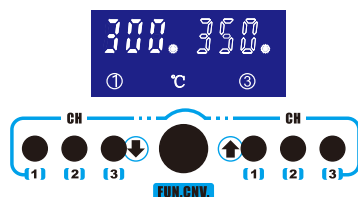

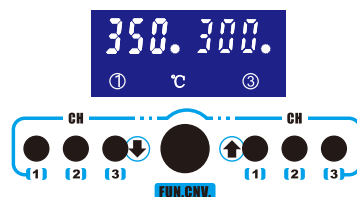

1-2. You can open tweezers/ soldering station 1 power switch at the same time.



2-1. When only open single soldering iron, press **FUN.CNV.** key, temperature flashing.  
2-2. When open tweezers/ soldering station 1 at the same time, press **FUN.CNV.** key twice, soldering station 2 CH3 temperature flashing.



3. Press **↓** key (cooling down) or **↑** key (heating up) adjust to desired temperature. For example: 350°C (long press the key -heating up or cooling down quickly, short press the key-heating up or cooling down step-by-step)

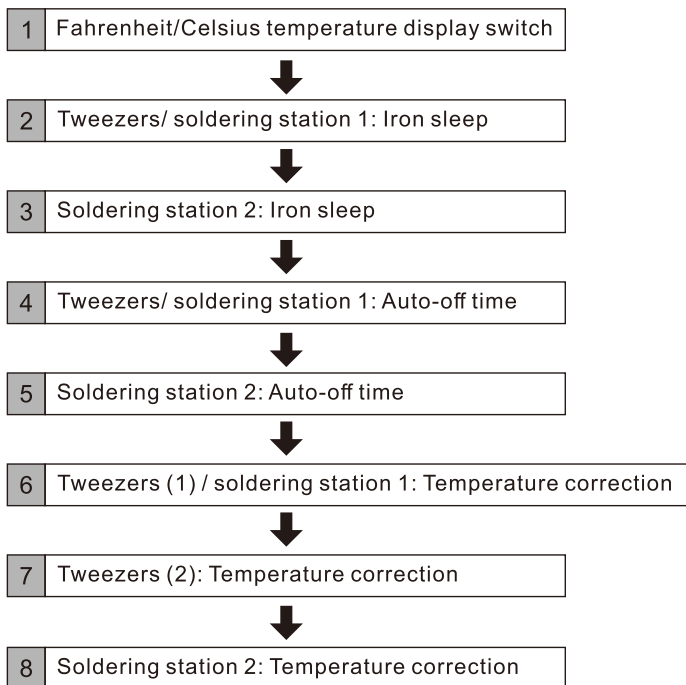


4. After adjust the temperature, stop operation. Soldering station 2 CH2 temperature flashing 6 times, system will auto memory data. The screen display soldering station 2 CH2 set temperature 3 seconds, soldering station CH2 setting completed.

2. Temperature calibration set to 30°C, press **FUN.CNV.** to increase, step by 1°C.



3. If need to change temperature calibration to 20°C, press key to decrease, step by 1 minute. Calibration range:  $\pm 50^{\circ}\text{C}$



4. After setting, wait for 3 seconds, turn off main power switch, system will auto memory data, complish setting (All function setting finished, if press **FUN.CNV.** key, cycle to 1.  $^{\circ}\text{C}/^{\circ}\text{F}$  converse display mode set )

# MAINTENANCE

## UNIT

1. Keep the unit plugged into a GROUNDED outlet at all times during operation.
2. Keep the unit and all components free from dirt, debris, and liquid at all times.
3. Make sure the power cord is plugged in correctly and safely off the floor to prevent accidents.
4. Keep all cords in the immediate workspace and avoid letting them hang off the side of a table or bench top.
5. Wipe the unit down, when needed, with a dry, static-free cloth.

## SOLDERING TIP CARE

1. For first use, allow the tip to rise to a stable temperature. Clean the tip on the damp sponge and tin the tip (apply a small amount of fresh solder to the tip).
2. Never hit the soldering iron or tip on anything to remove excess solder.
3. Do not use extreme temperature with the soldering iron tips, doing so will shorten the life span of the tip.
4. Clean the tip before each use, using the copper cleaning brush for better temperature stability during cleaning.
5. Always clean and re-tin the tip after each use. This will aid in the prevention of oxidation on the tip and help extend the life span.
6. Do not allow the soldering iron or the tips to sit idle at high temperatures for extended periods of time.
7. Never use a file or other abrasive materials to remove oxidation from the tips.
8. To remove oxidation, simply flood the tip with fresh solder and wipe it clean on the damp sponge or copper cleaning pad. This may need to be repeated several times for badly oxidized parts.
9. To remove the yellowing on the tip shaft, which is perfectly normal especially after first use, clean with 90% Isopropyl alcohol.

## INSTALL/REMOVE SOLDERING IRON TIP

1. Turn off the power to the unit and unplug from the power source.
2. Allow the soldering iron and tip to reach room temperature.
3. Loosen the nut at base of the metallic shaft of the soldering iron.
4. Slide the metallic tube off of the soldering iron and tip.
5. Slide the tip off of the heating element.
6. Repeat in the reverse order for installation. *Do not overtighten the nut on the soldering iron.*

## REPLACING THE SOLDERING TIP

1. Turn off the soldering station, unplug the power cord from the power source and allow the soldering iron to cool down to room temperature. Never attempt to remove the tip while the iron is hot.
2. Unscrew the small metal tip retaining screw cap at the bottom of the soldering irons metal shaft. Slide off or remove the soldering tip retaining collar. Now, remove the tip by sliding it forward.  
(There is NO need to remove the black Bakelite screw cap to change the tip.)
3. Slide a new tip over the exposed ceramic heating element, slide the metal retaining collar over the new soldering tip back onto the soldering iron.
4. Tighten the metal tip retaining screw cap to secure the tip into place. Do not over tighten the metal tip retaining screw cap.
5. Plug the soldering iron AC cord into a grounded outlet to resume soldering.

## BLACK BAKELITE SCREW CAP TIPS

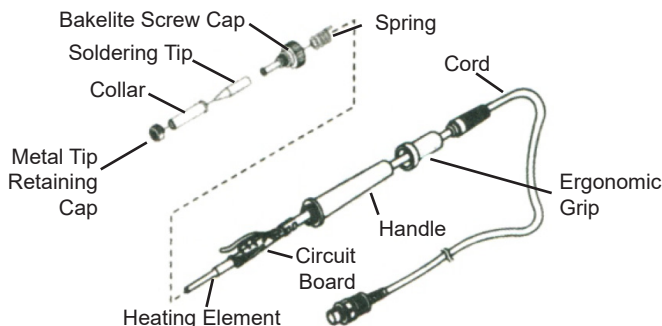
- Bakelite is a strong and stable material when handled correctly. This part cannot be made of metal for heat transfer safety reasons.
- The black Bakelite screw cap does NOT need to be removed to replace the tip. This is only removed to access the heating element.
- The Bakelite screw cap should never be tightened or re-tightened when the iron is hot. If the iron is not at room temperature when the Bakelite screw cap is removed it can cause it to crack.
- When tightening the Bakelite screw cap, at room temperature, it only needs to be snug - DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.

## SE ERROR MESSAGE

When the display shows “SE” this means that the heating element needs to be replaced. The heating element could be worn out or cracked.

**Note** that if you run the soldering iron in the 230°C ~ 280°C range, which is the normal temperature range for most “all” soldering applications, your heating element should last for 6 to 12 months depending on hours of use.

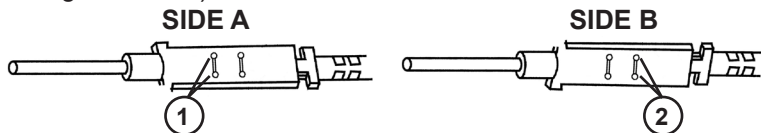
## REPLACING THE SOLDERING IRON HEATING ELEMENT



1. Turn off the unit and unplug it from the outlet. Allow the soldering iron to cool down to room temperature.  
**Never attempt to handle the tip while the iron is hot.**
2. Unscrew the Black Bakelite Screw Cap and slide off the full tip assembly.
3. Push the Cord through the bottom of the soldering iron while simultaneously pulling gently on the heating element to expose the circuit board.
4. De-solder the 2 thin / red or white wires from one side of the board and the 2 thick / blue wires from the other side of the board and pull the heating element away from the board.

**NOTE:** Record which side had the thin wires and which side had the thick wires so the replacement can be attached accordingly.

5. With the new heating element in place, solder the 2 thick / blue wires to the two lower solder joints on the circuit board (see Side A diagram below).
6. Flip the circuit board over and solder the 2 thin / red or white wires to the two upper solder joints on the circuit board (see Side B diagram below).

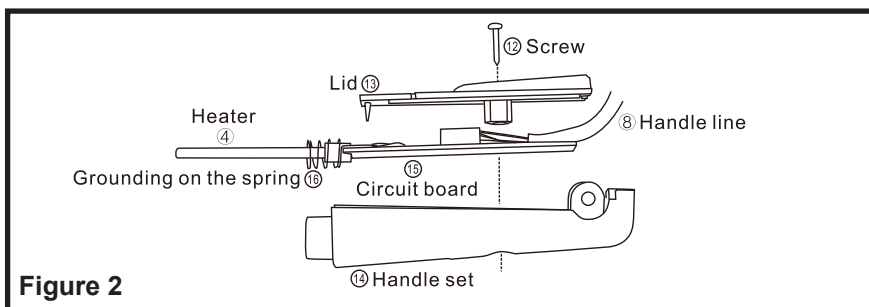
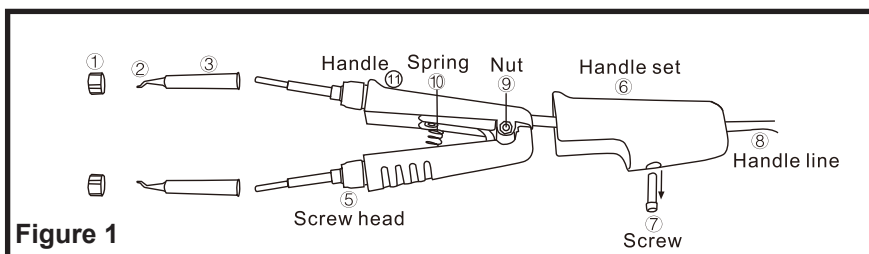


7. Pull the cord back gently and align the circuit board to the slots on the iron so the cord can be pulled back to its original position.
8. Replace Bakelite Polymer Retaining Cap and screw back on and hand tighten - Do NOT over-tighten.
9. Install the soldering tip, slide the metal soldering tip retaining collar and hand tighten it. Plug the AC cord back into a grounded outlet.

**NOTE:** The wires on the heating element can be soldered onto either side of the circuit board, as there is no polarity for the element.

## REPLACING THE HOT TWEEZERS HEATING ELEMENT

1. Turn off the unit and unplug it from the power source.
2. Allow the unit to reach room temperature before proceeding.
3. Disconnect the hot tweezers from the unit.
4. Unscrew the nut at the base of the tweezer tip (Figure 1 - #1).
5. Remove the pipe and tip - they do not separate (Figure 1 - #2 & #3).
6. Unscrew the screw on the one side of the handle (Figure 1 - #7).
7. Unscrew the screw in between the two sides (Figure 1 - #9).
8. Remove the spring (Figure 1 - 10).
9. Remove the handle from the Handle Set (Figure 1 - #11 & #6).
10. On the Handle Set unscrew the screw near the handle line (Figure 2 - #12).
11. Carefully remove the circuit board (Figure 2 - #15). Pay attention to where the ground connection is for the spring (Figure 2 - #16).
12. Unsolder the existing heating element, taking note of wire color and location (Figure 2 - #4).
13. Remove the heating element.
14. Replace the heating element.
15. Repeat instructions in reverse order to reassemble the hot tweezers.

## **WHAT DOES THIS WARRANTY COVER?**

This limited warranty covers defects in materials and workmanship of the product for the Warranty Period as defined below. In addition, during the Initial Warranty Period, this limited warranty also covers defects occurring in the initial shipment of the product to you.

## **WHAT DOES THIS WARRANTY NOT COVER?**

This limited warranty during the Warranty Period does not cover any damage due to: (a) improper use; (b) failure to follow the product instructions or to perform any preventive maintenance; (c) modifications; (d) unauthorized repair; (e) normal wear and tear that comes with household use; or (f) external causes such as accidents, abuse, or other actions or events beyond our reasonable control.
